B. CCRPC Recommendation to Allow Multifamily as a Permitted Use in Zoning District NC1 Discussion

C. Haiju introduced multiple options to explore for the recommendation to allow multifamily as a permitted use in Zoning District NC1. Further discussion took place. Chair, T. Micklus opened the floor for feedback from other meeting participants. Commission members agreed that this conversation was one that needed to be discussed further before any decision is made.

C. Public Utility Commission Notice for WRS Solar Installation

C. Haiju introduced a solar project being proposed by WRS at 321 Bear Trap Road. Their Public Utility Commission (PUC) application is intended to be submitted by the end of June 2022. The floor was opened to Commission members for thoughts and feedback. C. Haiju reminded Commission members that this application is to be reviewed against the current fencing regulations, and not the proposed fencing regulation changes discussed at the prior meeting as they have not been adopted. Action will be taken once the application has officially been submitted.
