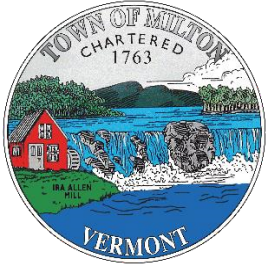

Discussion lead by Chief Laroche updating Committee of 2021 Use of Force Date report. 19 incidents where some type of force was required. 1 Handcuff Control Techniques, 12 Empty Hand Controls, 3 Firearms Active Point/ Warning, 3 CEW (Conducted Electronic Weapons) consisting of 1 display warning, 1 Drive Stun, 1 Darts used. Use of Force was used on 21 individuals, broken down race data to show 18 white and 3 black individuals.
