SCHOOL ARTICLES

ARTICLE I:

Shall the voters of Milton Town School District authorize the school board to expend Thirty Two Million, Six Hundred Forty Seven Thousand, Seven Hundred Eighty Six Dollars (\$32,647,786), which is the amount the school board has determined to be necessary for the ensuing fiscal year? It is estimated that this proposed budget, if approved, will result in education spending of \$14,971.16 per equalized pupil. This projected spending per equalized pupil is 4.21% higher than spending for the current year.
